Subject: REPORT ON FLOOD EMERGENCY / DISASTER MOCK EXERCISE

Reference to the subject cited above; a Flood Emergency Mock Exercise was carried out by Rescue 1122 in collaboration with line department on 25-05-2021 at River Ravi near Mari Pattan at 1000 hrs in order to check/develop liaison among disaster responding & relief departments/organizations/agencies in case of any untoward natural disaster in the district. Assistant Commissioner (Tandlianwala) supervised the exercise. Detail is as under:

The emergency response teams from the following departments/organizations/agencies participated in the mock exercise.

- Punjab Emergency Service (Rescue 1122)
- City District Government
- Irrigation Department
- Civil Defence
- Live Stock Department
- Agriculture Department
- TMA Tandlianwala
- Police
- Health Department

In addition to the teams from the above mentioned departments/organizations, Civil Defence Razakar and members from the Community Emergency Response Teams also participated in the mock exercise.

Concept & Execution Plan of Mock Exercise:

To check/develop liaison among disaster responding & relief departments/organizations/agencies in case of any untoward natural disaster in the district.

Role of Volunteers in Mock Exercise:

1. Conducting an initial size up in their areas.
2. Evacuating the victims of flood.

3. Providing basic treatment to the victims (in accordance with training guidelines imparted by Rescue 1122)"
4. Working with other community members and volunteers of Civil Defence to establish a command post, staging area, medical triage and treatment areas during flood."
5. Collecting damage information and developing a plan of operation based on life saving priorities and available resources. Establishing and maintaining communication with professional responders."
6. Interfacing with professional responders and assisting them as the need arises

Safety Planning & Measures:

Area was cordoned off by the police and a safety officer was deputed to ensure the safety of the staff, volunteers, bystanders and equipment.

Number of Participants:

A total number of 48 participants were involved in mock exercise

Risk Assessment during & after the Exercise

During exercise the risk of epidemic diseases was observed hence treatment of participants was advised in field hospital.

Tools / Equipments required & Inspection Mechanism

- Boats with OBMs
- Ambulance fully equipped
- Rescue vehicle
- Water Van fully equipped
- Live Stock Ambulance
- Live Stock vaccination bikes
- Civil Defense Rescue Vehicle
- Camps

Activities performed in mock exercise

The Following disaster related activities were carried out:

- Establishment of Incident Command Post (ICS)
- Formation of Water rescue post for Quick response at Chenab river
- Evacuation of flood victims
- Management of flood victims in field hospital at incident site
- Evacuation of animals and vehicles
- Vaccination of animals by live stock department
- Extrication of trapped victims
- Cutting of trees resisting the rescue activities

- Disconnection of electricity, Repair of damaged electricity cables

All the participating departments / agencies/organizations were evaluated for their response time, on ground coordination and operation duration as response time and on ground coordination was the crux of this mock exercise. All the departments/agencies/organizations managed their assigned tasks / scenario very efficiently and effectively by giving swift response.

The exercise ended with words of thanks by the guest.
